

Information on Applicant Programs 2011

1. **South Carolina Department of Mental Health—Shelter Plus Care Program in partnership with Mental Illness Recovery Center Inc. (HomeBase I & II) and Pilgrim’s Inn** – One year renewal grant to provide 57 housing units with supportive services for homeless individuals and families with mental illnesses or co-occurring substance use disorders in **City of Columbia, City of Rock Hill, Richland and Lexington Counties**.
2. **South Carolina Department of Mental Health —Shelter Plus Care Program in partnership with Mental Illness Recovery Center Inc. (HomeBase III & IV)** – One year renewal grant to provide 28 housing units with supportive services for homeless individuals and families with mental illnesses or co-occurring substance use disorders in **City of Columbia and Richland County**.
3. **South Carolina Department of Mental Health —Shelter Plus Care Program in partnership with Mental Health America in SC (MHASC)**— One year renewal grant to provide 32 housing units with supportive services for homeless individuals and families with mental illnesses or co-occurring substance use disorders in **Aiken, Barnwell, Bamberg, Allendale and Orangeburg Counties**.
4. **Healing Properties – Phase I & II** – One year renewal grant to provide 39 permanent housing units and supportive services for homeless disabled people in **Columbia and Richland County**. \$79,046 for a one year renewal.
5. **Richland County Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)** – One year renewal grant for the database used to track housing and services utilized by homeless people utilized in **Allendale, Aiken, Bamberg, Barnwell, Calhoun, Chester, Columbia, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster, Lexington, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, Rock Hill and York**. \$80,544 for a one year renewal
6. **Richland County Homeless Management Information System Expansion (HMIS)** – One year new grant to expand the database used to track housing and services utilized by homeless individuals utilized in **Allendale, Aiken, Bamberg, Barnwell, Calhoun, Chester, Columbia, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster, Lexington, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, Rock Hill and York**. \$40,000 for a one year new grant.
7. **Samaritan House** – One year renewal grant to provide 20 units of transitional housing and services to homeless people in **Orangeburg**. \$101,812 for a one year renewal.
8. **Sistercare** – One year renewal grant to provide 39 permanent housing units and services to homeless women who are victims of domestic violence serving **Columbia, Richland and Lexington Counties**. \$279,410 for a one year renewal.
9. **St. Lawrence Place** – One year renewal grant to provide 28 transitional housing units for families with children in the **City of Columbia and Richland County**. \$80,317 for a one year renewal.
10. **United Way of Kershaw County** – One year renewal grant to provide 10 transitional housing units to homeless families with children in **Kershaw County**. \$83,100 for a one year renewal.
11. **Columbia Housing Authority I** – One year renewal grant to provide 6 permanent housing units for homeless people with chronic disabilities in **City of Columbia, Richland and Lexington County**. \$ 68,996 for a one year renewal.
12. **Columbia Housing Authority II** – One year renewal grant to provide 13 permanent housing units for homeless persons with disabilities in **Richland and Lexington County**. \$144,825 for a one year renewal.

13. **Columbia Housing Authority Housing First Phase II** – Three year new grant to expand to 8 additional permanent housing units for homeless people with chronic disabilities in **City of Columbia, Richland and Lexington County**. \$208,656 for a three year new grant.
14. **Columbia Housing Authority Housing First Phase III** – Three year new grant to expand 12 additional permanent housing for homeless individuals and families with chronic disabilities in **City of Columbia, Richland, and Lexington County**. \$338,612 for a three year new grant.
15. **Growing Home Southeast** – One year renewal grant to provide 6 transitional housing units for youth in **City of Columbia, Richland and Lexington County**. \$26,250 for a one year renewal.
16. **Mental Health of America/Aiken** – Two year new grant to provide 12 transitional housing units for homeless women with children in **Aiken County**. \$120,398 for a two year new grant.
